Information for PARENTS/CARERS

- Please continue to participate in the twice-weekly LFD testing of your child at home.
 Your child <u>must not</u> enter the school site if they have any COVID-19 symptoms. Please keep them at home in and arrange for a PCR test to be undertaken. Please inform the school of symptoms and results of tests at the earliest opportunity. Please report positive test results to <u>covid19@davisonhigh.school</u>
- Please ensure that your daughter uses a Lateral Flow testing Device (LFD) twice each week (we recommend Monday and Thursday mornings) and awaits the result before leaving home for school.
- Keep your emergency contact numbers available at all times in case we need to contact you (Please ensure that phones are not on silent and are charged.)
- Please ensure that your child does not enter the school site before 8.00am as staff will be supervising entry and hand-sanitising.
- Please ensure that your child is in full school uniform.
- Please ensure that your child comes to school with a personal supply of 'Alcohol Hand Sanitiser' and washes their hands upon entry. This sanitiser must be used on entry, to the school, and regularly throughout each day in conjunction with frequent hand-washing.
- Students will not be required to wear face coverings in lessons or on corridors and communal areas, until further notice, but we would support any student who wishes to use a face covering in any of those settings.
- Please ensure your child has all books and stationery. We will be minimising the sharing of equipment as much as possible throughout the Autumn term in the first instance.
- Please be aware that plans are subject to change, at short notice, in line with any PHE or Government announcements.
- Please read all communications from the school. Check the website for reminders if necessary. Please read and respond to all e-mails when requested.
- Please make the school aware of any Health Care issues that may impact upon your child's safety/wellbeing. (Contact your child's Lead Tutor, if you have concerns of a pastoral nature, or Student Services if the concern is medical.)
- Please factor in plenty of time for your child to arrive at school and be aware of changes to train timetables or local roads.
- Please rest assured that the school will have clear protocols if children become ill on site. All PHE guidance will be followed.
