Re: Relationships and Sex Education contraception lesson for Year 10 students

I am pleased to inform you that as part of the Relationships and Sex Education programme at Davison, we will be leading two-hour long lessons about contraception and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in a Personal Development lesson during this half term.

During the first lesson, the teacher will discuss with the students the concept of consent, that deep love and respect form the basis of any sexual relationship, the reasons for using contraception and about the different types of contraception available.

The second lesson will focus upon sexually transmitted infections (STIs). The students will learn about the characteristics of STIs, how transmission can be prevented and where to go should they need help and advice in the future.

I am sure that you will agree that these lessons will enable your daughter to learn invaluable information regarding the risks of unprotected sexual activity as well the choices available in her long-term future.

These lessons would normally take place during Year 9, but unfortunately, due to Covid-19 have had to be re-scheduled to the beginning of Year 10.
