

Information for PARENTS/CARERS

- Your child must not enter the school site if they have any COVID-19 symptoms. Please keep them at home in isolation and arrange for a test to be undertaken. Please inform the school of symptoms and results of tests at the earliest opportunity by emailing covid19@davisonhigh.school
- Keep your emergency contact numbers available at all times and ensure we have your up to date details. (Please ensure that phones are not on silent and are charged.)
- If you drive your daughter to school, please drop her at a socially safe distance, from other students, and arrange to collect her at a location which will be safe and away from other students/family members.
- Please ensure that your daughter does not enter the school site before 8.00am as staff will be supervising entry and hand-sanitising from 8.00am onwards.
- Please ensure that your daughter is in full school uniform. Students may have to be collected if there is no spare capacity within a 'Year Group Zone' to house students not in uniform.
- Please ensure that your daughter comes to school with a personal supply of 'Alcohol Hand Sanitiser' and washes her hands upon entry into her 'Year Group Zone' area. This sanitiser must be used on entry to the school, and regularly throughout each day in conjunction with frequent hand-washing.
- Please support us by ensuring that your daughter understands the need for consistently high standards of behaviour. Sanctions may increase more quickly if we cannot operate our normal policies due to covid-19 restrictions.
- The government recommends that the use of face coverings in secondary schools is extended for a limited period to all indoor environments - including classrooms - unless 2m social distancing can be maintained. In view of this, please ensure that your daughter has one, and a sealable plastic bag for storage, before she leaves home (there are exceptions to the rule for when wearing a face covering would affect your ability to take part in "exercise or strenuous activity" such as PE, or for anyone who doesn't wear a mask for health reasons).
- Please ensure your daughter has all books and stationery. There will NOT be sharing of equipment under current restrictions.
- Your daughter is requested to wear PE kit to school on days where PE is on her timetable. Please note that only black and navy sports jogging/tracksuit bottoms can be worn in addition to the school skirt. The school will accept discreet sports logos but not large logos/wording/continuous stripes.
- Parents must only enter the site if they have a pre-arranged meeting. Please report to Reception if this is the case.
- Please be aware that any plans are subject to change, at short notice, in line with PHE or Government announcements.
- Please try to find alternatives to using public transport.
- If unavoidable...please spend time discussing the most safe way your daughter can use public transport (queuing and sitting at safe distances, using debit cards to pay for tickets, using hand sanitiser before, and after, accessing the train/bus/taxi, having a face mask/covering.)

- Please read all communications from the school. Check the website for reminders if necessary. Please read and respond to all e-mails when requested.
- Please make the school aware of any Health Care issues that may impact upon your daughter's safety/wellbeing. (Contact your daughter's Lead Tutor, if you have concerns of a pastoral nature, or Student Services if the concern is medical.)
- Please ensure your daughter has drinks/snacks and a coat/sun-cream in accordance with weather forecasts.
- Please factor in plenty of time for your child to arrive at school and be aware of changes to train timetables or local roads (as a result of roadworks.)
- Please help us all to stay safe by ensuring that your daughter, and other family members, operate within Government Guidelines at all times outside of school.
- Please do not transport any child, who does not live with you, to school in a motor vehicle.
- Please rest assured that the school will have clear protocols if children become ill on site. All PHE guidance will be followed. Please note that the early release times have been devised in conjunction with train availability. Our aim is to stagger release from the school site and ensure that there is more room on the trains used by our students. Early release arrangements will be regularly reviewed.
