Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you of important information regarding the collection of examination results this year. We want this to be a celebratory process, in the same way that it always is. In view of this, students will be able to collect their GCSE results, from the school Refectory, on **Thursday 12th August 2021**. There will be staff, on site, to support and answer any questions.
