Taster Day for Yr10 students at Worthing College

Your daughter will be starting to make choices regarding her post 16 provision. Pupils can book their taster day using the Eventbrite links in the attached document from Worthing College.

Please book 4 sessions on 15th July (there are options for 14th July – please do not book).

Travel: Students will make their own way to and from the college.

Lunch: Bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch at the college canteen. If your daughter receives Free School Meals and would like a lunch provided, please order from the Diner the day before and a member of staff will take it to the college for her.

Requirements: Non-uniform. However, please be aware of our requirements that students should choose clothing appropriate to a professional environment with no midriffs on show. Pens and pencils.

Expectation: Students will need to catch up on work missed if attending a taster day, and they will need to let their teachers know that they will not be in school.

Cost: There is no cost for this trip

If your daughter has booked onto a taster day, there is no need to complete an absence form but she must return the slip below to her form tutor, so that her absence can be coded as authorised. The college will also notify the school of your daughter's registration on the day for safeguarding reasons. We hope your daughter enjoys this opportunity.
