I am provided with the resources and equipment needed for me to fully participate in lessons e.g. Maths set & calculator and DT resources/ingredients.

In the Sapphire POD the PP Mentors make me feel safe and cared for. They look after my emotional wellbeing.

I can loan a school laptop to ensure I can study at home.

My teachers utilise classroom strategies and learning tools for maximum impact to enhance my progress.

School offer lots of residential trips and I can apply for funding support to go too.

I can access a free breakfast in the morning to make sure I start the day well.

There is range of specialist help on site if I should need it, including counselling and health advice. And I can be quickly signposted to other services.

My progress is monitored as a priority by my teachers and I am invited to booster sessions for focused intervention.

Raising Attainment Coaches are employed especially to support my Maths and English, enabling me to fulfil my potential and get the best possible outcomes.



All my curriculum school trips are subsidised to make sure I can go on them to enrich my learning.

I am helped with my attendance and punctuality and I'm proud to be in school, making every day count!

The Careers Leader ensures I receive personal careers advice and guidance and access to post 16 option choices.

There is assistance available to make sure I am always dressed correctly for school, including PE kit and shoes. I can also visit the Pre-loved Uniform store

In Year 11, I am given help preparing for my exams; I am provided with my GCSE textbooks and revision materials/aids and a revision pack. I'm appointed a mentor where appropriate.

My successes are celebrated and rewarded.

Where needed, I have a trusted adult in school who is my 'champion', boosts my confidence and encourages me to believe in myself.

I'm encouraged to take up subsidised music lessons, perform and join school groups.

I am supported to develop my 'learning to learn' skills to become a more responsible and independent learner.
