To make the occasion more enjoyable, students are invited to wear home clothes for a voluntary donation, enabling us to raise money for 'Love Your Hospital' and the 'Friends of Davison School' 'FODS' our PTA. FODS hold events throughout the year, raising funds for School projects benefiting the whole school community.

Love Your Hospital is the dedicated NHS charity for St Richard's, Worthing and Southlands Hospitals. They support NHS staff to provide the very best care to patients and their families. They are currently raising money to purchase Gaming Carts for their children's wards. These Gaming Carts are customised and specifically built for the medical environment. Each Cart helps healthcare professionals, play specialists, and play facilitators provide much-needed recreation and play to children and young people who are immobile, spending time in the hospital, or visiting as an outpatient.
