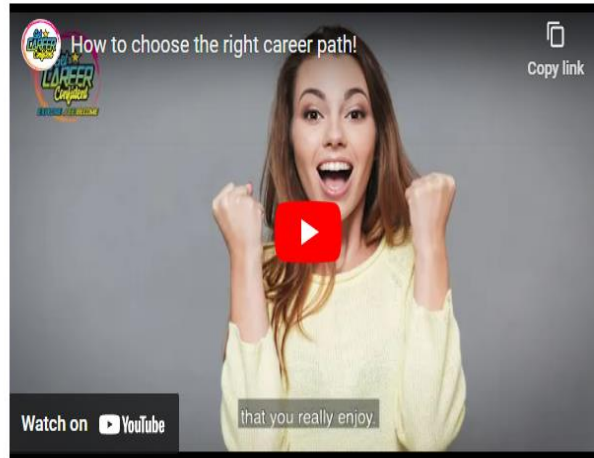

Qualification Levels

- Colleges will offer courses are a range of levels. In broad terms:
- Level 1 – these are designed for students who have yet to achieve GCSE grades
- Level 2 – these are designed for students who have achieved GCSE grades 1, 2 and 3
- Level 3 – these are designed for students who have achieved GCSE grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9

GCSE Maths and GCSE English

Students who do not achieve GCSE grade 4 or above in August will be required to re-take the GCSE next year at college.



Courses at Further Education Colleges

Vocational courses; practical and skills based

- Subjects like Mechanical Engineering, Sport & Exercise Science, Health & Social Care, Air Cabin Crew, Architecture and Interior, Childcare, Animal Management and Hairdressing can be studied as a Certificate or Diploma.
- 1yr = Certificate, Diploma, T Level depending on the course level
- 2yr = Extended Diploma or T Level (equivalent to 3 A levels)
 - MMM = 96 UCAS points, equivalent to 3 C grades at A level
 - D*D*D* = 168 UCAS points, equivalent to 3 A* grades at A level
- You study 1 subject which creates a full timetable

A Levels

2 year course with exams at the end of the two years

Generally choose 3 subjects. Can do 4 if gaining high GCSE grades

Universities do not require 4 A levels; getting better grades from 3 is more helpful than not so good grades from 4, also time for a social life and super curricular stuff!

Exciting new subjects e.g. economics, photography, law, psychology, sociology

BTEC, WJEC and CAMTEC Subjects such as Applied law, applied science, applied psychology, health & social care, criminology, digital media, engineering

You can mix A levels with BTECs, WJECs and CAMTECs

What are T Levels?

T Levels were launched in September 2020.

They follow GCSEs and will be the equivalent of 3 A-Levels.

What type of study is this?

T-Levels combine classroom theory and a 45 day (approx.) industry placement, which will give you the skills and experience employers are looking for.

How long does it take to complete T Levels?

International Baccalaureate -IB

An international qualification, continuing to study a range of subjects

Choose one course from each of the six subject areas

Three at the Higher Level and three at the Standard Level, the content of Standard Level courses is smaller than that of Higher Level courses

Theory of Knowledge - A study of the foundations of knowledge

Extended essay - 4,000 words on a topic of particular interest in any subject

A programme of extra-curricular activities

Students need high grades across all subjects to apply and it is only offered at Varndean College in Brighton.



Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships combine practical training with study

As an apprentice, you'll:

- work alongside experienced staff and gain job-specific skills
- earn a wage, minimum of £4.15 p/h and get holiday pay
- be given time for study related to your role (the equivalent of one day a week)
- Intermediate L2 – equivalent to 5 GCSE passes at grade 9 – 4
- Advanced L3 – equivalent to 2 A level passes/Level 3 Diploma

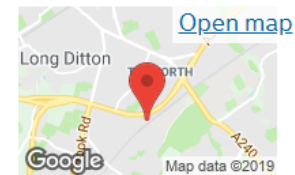

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS - WORTHING COLLEGE

Specific entry requirements for courses at Worthing College

Level 3 courses

Applied Law BTEC	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language.
Applied Psychology BTEC	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4 including grade 4 in English Language and Maths.
Applied Science CAMTEC (Single or Double)	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including double 4 in Science and 4 in Mathematics.
Biology A Level	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language, grade 5 in Maths and double 6 in Science GCSE, or 6 in Biology plus a 6 in another Science.
Business CAMTEC (Single or Double)	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language or Maths.
Business A Level	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language and Maths.
Chemistry A Level	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language, grade 6 in Maths and double 6 in Science GCSE, or 6 in Chemistry plus a 6 in another Science.
Computer Science A Level	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 6 in Mathematics and grade 4 in English Language.
Computing BTEC	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4 including grade 4 in Maths.
Creative and Performing Arts RSL	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language or Maths.
Criminology WJEC	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language.
Dance A Level	You need a minimum of five GCSEs at 9-4, including grade 4 in English Language and Maths.





APPLICATION PROCESS

- Process starts now:
- Study the online prospectus or order a hard copy to be sent through the post
- Recommended that students visit college open evenings; online reservations may have to be made
- Recommended that students apply during November and December
- Applications are online
- Students can use Year 10 Forecast Grades; Year 11 forecast grades available after the half term
- Most colleges will interview and expect you to bring your last School Report to interview
- We will send a reference, if requested, for each student
- The deadline for Bhasvic and Varndean is Friday, 2nd December 2022
