Overview

The Subject Leader of Computing and ICT will need to have an in-depth knowledge of the GCSE subject content and the KS3 National Curriculum. The successful candidate will also be responsible for supporting, developing and enhancing the subject knowledge and teaching pedagogy of non-specialist computing teachers.

Main duties

Ensure high standards of teaching, learning and attainment within the Computing and ICT Department.

Deliver a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum for students, in accordance with the aims of the School and curricular policies determined by the Governing Body.

Act as a Lead for all Computing and ICT courses and manage the department on a day-to-day basis.

Monitor and support the overall progress and development of students.

Possess the ability to plan and lead the curriculum for Computing at KS3 and 4.

Establish links with other organisations to enrich the learning experience of the students, whilst also maintaining links with partner schools, local colleges and businesses in the community.

Lead the development of appropriate resources, schemes of work, marking policies, assessment and teaching strategies in the department.

Liaise with the Data and Exams Manager to maintain accreditation with the relevant examination and validating bodies.

Promote teamwork and motivate staff to ensure effective working relations.

Work with the ICT support team to ensure that appropriate, up-to-date software is being used where possible.

Whole-school responsibility for leading e-safety and e-learning across the curriculum.

Assist in the facilitation of training for staff, parents and students on the school's VLE system.

Effectively promote Computing and ICT at Open Evenings and other school events.

Manage the Departmental budget. Take on the duties of a form tutor.

Attend scheduled Subject Leader meetings and contribute effectively.

Take a proactive approach to professional development of all colleagues within the department, including personal professional development.

Uphold all school polices to the highest standards and undertake all other reasonable duties as specified by the Headteacher.

- Teach and model engaging and effective subject teaching that motivates, inspires and improves pupil attainment.
- Plan and implement a subject curriculum that ensures coherence and progression in the teaching of key subject knowledge, skills, understanding and concepts.
- Monitor, evaluate and continually improve the quality of planning, teaching and assessment of all members of the department.
- Lead the assessment process in the department.
- Analyse student performance data and respond to the outcomes of assessment to ensure appropriate planning, teaching and interventions.
