Provide an opportunity for parents to meet with subject staff via subject consultation evenings Respond to requests for additional information in a timely way, we endeavour to acknowledge communications from parents within 2 working days. Communicate in a polite and respectful manner. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read reports and respond if appropriate Endeavour to attend subject consultation evenings and Information Evenings. Check all communications from the school Make every reasonable effort to address communications to the appropriate member of staff in the first instance and using the most appropriate method of communication (see communication policy here.)
