



Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the second half of the Summer Term our Year 10 students will be almost halfway through their GCSE courses. We will be conducting a series of Mock Examinations from **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June**.

Some of these examinations will be conducted in our Sports Hall and Main Hall, to provide an experience for the students similar to the real GCSEs. This will include following the full range of rules and regulations used in GCSEs. Option subjects will conduct their Mock Examinations in classrooms during their option time.

To support students during this time we have put in place the following arrangements:

- Both parents and students have been emailed a copy of the exam timetable to help plan a revision programme
- Form Tutors have been given seating plan posters so students can easily check where they will be seated for examinations that are conducted in the Hall or Sports Hall
- A Year 10 Mock Frog Site is now available in student's digital planners. This provides videos with advice on revision methods as well as links to information about managing stress during examinations. It will also have guidance on the rules of the examination room.
- Year 10 teachers will have given students an indication of the topics that may be covered in their examinations to help them prepare.
