Re: Relationships and Sex Education contraception lesson for Year 9 students

I am pleased to inform you that as part of the Relationships and Sex Education programme at Davison, we will be leading two one-hour long lessons about contraception in Personal Development lessons during June and July.

During the first lesson, the teacher will discuss with the students the concept of consent, that deep love and respect form the basis of any sexual relationship and the reasons for using contraception.

The second lesson will focus upon the different types of contraception available. The students will learn about the characteristics of STIs, how transmission can be prevented and where to go should they need help and advice in the future.

Throughout the two lessons, the teacher will ensure that the lessons are taught in a sensitive and inclusive manner, and in a manner that reflects the Christian and caring ethos of the school.

I am sure that you will agree that these lessons will enable your daughter to learn invaluable information regarding the risks of unprotected sexual activity as well the choices available in her long-term future.
